The Wine:

100% Tempranillo hand harvested from nearby San Vicente Valley and processed using traditional, artisanal methods. We love the plush New World expression of this famous Spanish grape that grows prolifically here in our sunny Baja climate. Our Bold Sister has twelve months in mixed barrels and displays silky tannins, dark fruit, earthiness, and a hint of spice.

In Wine We Lust:

The winemaker, Sitara, locally known as “Baja Valley Girl,” has been making wine in the Guadalupe Valley since 2012. She began by making wine on her back porch, using a spare bedroom to age the wines in barrel, and selling the wine from her front porch tasting bar. All of the wines produced by Sitara are lovingly crafted, friendly and approachable.

Tasting Notes:

Color: Red currant.

Aromas: Fresh olives, plum, forest floor.

Flavors and Textures: Mouth filling and well-balanced, look for bittersweet chocolate, fruit leather, blackberry, green olives, leather, and clove.

Food Pairing: Smokey pulled pork, marlin a la Veracruzana, traditional Osso Buco.

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
